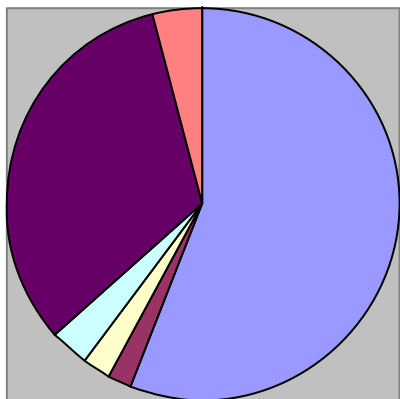


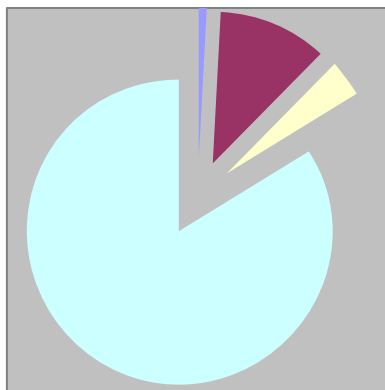

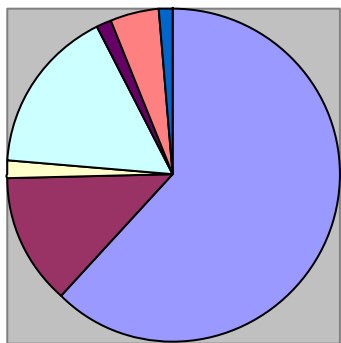

SUMMER READING PROGRAM (Youth Department)

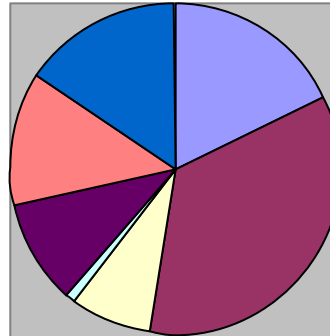
- 450 children (0-18) registered

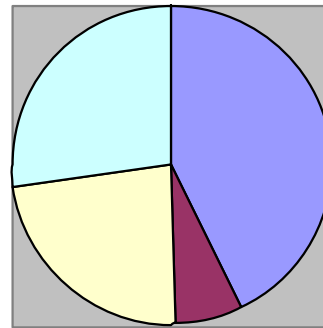
