

Policy Statement

The Comstock Township Library provides free high-speed internet for patrons wishing to pursue their information needs with the convenience and technological flexibility of using their own equipment.

Regulations

1. Patrons are welcome to use their own personal computing equipment to access the wireless internet within the library.
 2. Use of the internet with patron-provided equipment is governed by the library's *Internet Access, Use, & Safety Policy INFO-2*.
 3. Library staff will provide general guidelines on the procedures necessary to access the wireless internet connections, but are not responsible for any changes patrons make to their computer settings and cannot guarantee that a patron's hardware will work with the library's network.
 4. The responsibility for security shall lie with the patron. The library shall not be responsible for the possible interception of wireless connections, computer viruses, and other malware, nor the risks of transmitting personal data.
 5. Patrons connecting to the internet with their own equipment are able to print to the library's printers and pay for printouts the same as those using the library's computers.
 6. Patrons with their own equipment may use the library's electrical outlets to power their devices.
